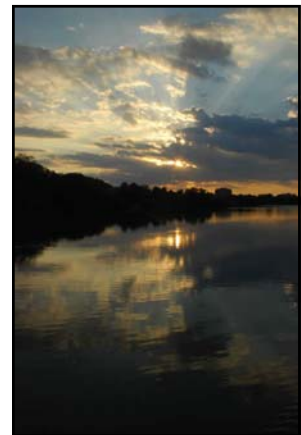
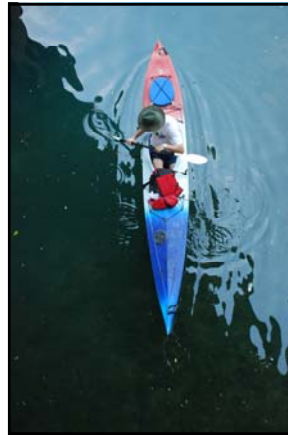

## Water Exploration Workshop

The *Water Exploration* workshop will provide training on the implementation of the Texas Water Development Board's new high school online curriculum. *Water Exploration* uses a project-based learning approach to promote inquiry learning about water science and critical water-related issues. All learning activities and re-sources are packaged into Legacy Cycles modules, an innovative approach that engages students in the use of the Internet and computer technology, as well as laboratory and field-based activities, to conduct their research. The new national Earth Science Literacy Principles provide the organizing framework for the lessons and activities in each *Water Exploration* Legacy Cycle.

The *Water Exploration* curriculum addresses the TEKS for high school science course such as Earth and Space Science, AP Environmental Science, Environmental Systems, Biology, and Aquatic Science, as well as Geography.
